Mission and Strategies

South Shore Clean Cities' mission is to preserve and revitalize Northern Indiana by promoting the use of clean fuels and clean vehicle technologies. We work towards this mission through education and outreach, training, acquiring necessary funding to implement projects, and developing stakeholder partnerships.

The coalition's fuel portfolio includes biodiesel, ethanol, electricity, hydrogen, natural gas, and propane. Additionally, the coalition advocates for idle reduction and fuel economy technologies.

SSCC employs three main strategies:

- ◆ Replace petroleum with alternative and renewable fuels.
- ◆ Reduce petroleum consumption through smarter driving practices and fuel economy improvements.
- ◆ Decrease petroleum use through idle reduction and other fuel-saving technologies and practices.
